What can I expect when I call?

One of our psychiatrists will return your call within 30 minutes or a time that is convenient for you. They will answer your questions about diagnostic tests, medications, treatment plans, and more.

What information will I need when I call?

- Age of child
- Race/ethnicity
- Gender
- Insurance coverage
- Zip code
- Foster care status
- Safety concerns
- Current diagnosis
- New or follow up consults
- Reason for call
